

Redondo Baseball Tournament 2009 Coaches: <u>Read This Page!</u>

Coaches, I want to introduce myself, I am the new coach at Redondo and the field is set for the 2009 Redondo Baseball Tournament. We have 40 teams in six pools competing for three Division Championships. In the Red and the White division, 4 six-team pools will play **four pool games** and the winners of each pool within a division will play for a championship. In the blue division, 2 eight-team pools will follow the same format. Pool winner tie breakers are: 1) Head to Head, 2) Runs Allowed, 3) Runs Scored, 4) Team Overall Record, 5) Coin Flip. **IMPORTANT:** If there are two 4-0 teams from the same pool and no 4-0 teams from the opposite pool, the 4-0 teams will play for the Division Championship. Adjustments will be made to make sure league teams don't meet in championship games. Other than championship games, fifth round games will be determined based on competitive play, geography, number of home games and coaches' requests.

For JV teams, each school is guaranteed 3 games, with any three win team getting a fourth game. JV teams will normally play the same opponent as the varsity at the opposite site, but there are exceptions. **PLEASE DOUBLE CHECK THE JV GAMES** to make sure who you are playing. (If I have put you in the JV portion of the tournament and you did not plan to play, contact me ASAP!)I will make sure that every varsity team has at least 2 home games. There are also featured games throughout the tournament that will be played at Redondo Union High, as will the three championship games. Entry fee for all games at Redondo Union High is \$3.00 for adults and \$1.00 for students.

<u>Rescheduling Games:</u> We have at least three different Spring Break periods for teams participating in the tournament. I know there are going to be conflicts, so we will all have to be flexible. If you cannot play on a regular scheduled day for the tournament, it is your responsibility to contact the opposing coach and come up with a mutually agreed upon date to reschedule the game. Then you must contact the umpire assignor in your area to inform him of the change. Finally, you should let me know of the change.

<u>Rain Outs</u>: The same procedure should be followed for any rain outs. Originally scheduled games must be played on the day they are scheduled.

Umpires: I strongly recommend that you check to make sure your umpire assignor has assigned umpires for all your home games, both varsity and JV. I cannot help you with umpires on Saturday morning. I give Lou Smith, the assignor in the South Bay, all games and he forwards out of area games to local assignors. The local assignors then give the games to your local umpires. Contacting your assignor ahead of time can prevent a lot of problems. Umpires are paid through the tournament entry fees, as is an assignor fee for each game.

Tournament Rules: 1) Home team provides baseballs. 2) There is no time limit for varsity games (except for games at Redondo Union High, no new inning after 2:45). JV regular season time limit rules apply. 3) Mercy Rule must be agreed upon by both coaches. 4) As in CIF contests, no protests can be considered.

We have a tremendously competitive field once again this year, I am looking forward to a great tournament.
